Whereas the Deputy Commissioner, Ganderbal vide his letter No: 561-62/DCG/W-Tree/220 KV D/C ZAPTL /2017 dated: 08-09-2017 recommended the case for grant of permission for felling down of 122 identified walnut trees which were coming under the corridor of construction of 220 KV D/C Zainakote-Alusteng Power Transmission Line, accordingly this office issued permission for felling down of these 122 No's. of walnut trees under permit No. 60 PST/PA vide endorsement No: DivCom/TS/(1194)/2017 dated: 09-11-2017; and

Whereas; the said permission could not be implemented on ground within the stipulated time due to the ownership dispute of 12 No's. of walnut trees at tower location No. 104 & 105. Resultantly the Deputy Commissioner, Ganderbal vide his letter No:1090-91/DCG/W-Tree/220 KV D/C ZAPTL /2018 dated: 27-11-2018 requested for grant of extension of validity of the above mentioned permission order which was turned down on the plea that there was no provision for extension of the permission issued under Specified Tree Rules. In response the the Deputy Commissioner, Ganderbal vide his letter No: 119697/DCG/W-Tree/220 KV D/C ZAPTL /019 dated: 19-01-2019 again requested for revalidation of the above said permission order and ;

Whereas; the Deputy Commissioner, Ganderbal vide his letter No: 1223/DCG/W-Tree/220 KV D/C ZAPTL /019 dated: 29-01-2019 communicated that the ownership dispute of 12 No's. of walnut trees at tower location No. 104 & 105 has been now amicably resolved between the two parties and also requested for grant of fresh permission for felling down of left out 49 walnut trees, which implies that 73 No's. of identified walnut trees which were lying within the corridor of said power transmission line are to be felled down and;

Whereas; the request of the Deputy Commissioner, Ganderbal for grant of fresh permission for felling of remaining 49 No's. of walnut trees was not acceded, and he vide this office letter No: DivCom/Tree/1194/2018-222 dated: 07-02-2019 was asked to furnish the detailed/specific report with his recommendations regarding number of walnut trees to be felled down, besides communicate the number of walnut trees felled down out of 122 No's. of walnut trees coming under the alignment of construction of said power transmission line and;

Whereas; in response to this office letter No: DivCom/Tree/1194/2018-222 dated: 07-02-2019, the Deputy Commissioner, Ganderbal vide his letter No:F-133/DCG/WT/2019 dated:14-05-2019 while endorsing the request of Executive Engineer, Transmission Line Construction Division 2nd Bemina Srinagar, requested for revalidation of the permission for a further period of 60 days to cut down remaining 49 No's. of walnut trees coming under the corridor of construction of 220 KV D/C Zainakote-Alusteng Power Transmission Line and ;

In the back drop of above, and in pursuance of the provisions of Section 5 of Jammu and Kashmir Preservation of specified Trees Act, 1969, and as recommended by the Deputy Commissioner, Ganderbal, sanction is hereby accorded for felling of left out already Identified 49 No's of walnut trees coming under the alignment of construction of 220 KV Zainakote Alasteng Transmission Line in favour of Tehsildar Lar/Wakura. The permit issued vide permit No. 60 PST/PA under endorsement No: DivCom/TS/(1194)/2017 dated: 09-11-2017 in respect of 122 walnut trees is restricted to 73 walnut trees only
