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Subject:- Minutes of the meeting held under the chairmanship of Divisional Commissioner Kashmir on 30-05-2016 in connection with arrangements for Shri Amarnath Ji Yatra-2016.

A meeting under the chairmanship of Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir was convened on 30-05-2016 to discuss the arrangements to be made for conduct of Shri Amarnathji Yatra 2016 by various Govt Departments and adequate arrangements for security.

List of the participants is enclosed as Annexure-A

At the outset, the participants introduced themselves to the chair and the chair appreciated the efforts put in by the officials of various departments/organizations for conduct of 2015 Yatra successfully.


It was impressed upon all officers of Civil/Police/Army/Para Military Forces to maintain seamless synergy and jointmanship to make Yatra-2016 successful. Department wise arrangements discussed and preparedness by different Departments was assessed. The Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir instructed all line officers to implement the decisions taken in HLC in letter and spirit.

The following decisions were taken in the meeting:-

1. The Health Department in addition will keep the heart specialists available at the camp Hospitals. Besides, critical care Ambulances & Oxygen cylinders in good quantity will be kept available.
2. The PDA was directed to complete the track by 15th June 2016 and a damaged strip of track about 400 meter be repaired. The DC, Anantnag will monitor the execution of work on the track. The chair was informed that R&B Deptt. will hand over 2 Baily Bridges on Baltal side by 10th June. CEO, PDA informed the chair that 40 snow-sheds have been cleared and left out 9 snow-sheds will be cleared by 10-15th June.
3. The CE, PDD informed that all arrangements will be made and electric supply from Baltal to Domel will be restored by 10th June and sufficient number of Generators will be made available as well.

4. The CE, PHE informed that all arrangements for drinking water will be made in time as per past practice. Besides, informed the chair that 5 Fire Hydrants has been installed out of 9. Remaining 4 Fire Hydrants will be installed by 15th June, 2016.
5. The CE, I&FC apprised the chair that DPR amounting to Rs. 346.46 lacs have been submitted to I&FC Department for taking debris flow control measures around Base camp of Shri Amarnath Ji Yatra at Baltal. However, work on construction of catch water drain is going on at Base Camp at an estimated cost of Rs. 14.00 lacs with drain near Helipad. The chair directed CE, I&FC Deptt. to pursue the case in Administrative Deptt.
6. Chief Wildlife Warden was directed to take preventive measures with regard to bear attacks on the Amarnath Ji Yatra routes.
7. The CA & PD Deptt will make all arrangements in respect of essential commodities at Base Camp up to 20th June.
8. The Health Deptt informed that adequate no. of Ambulances have been made ready (from Pahalgam side and Baltal side) and all other arrangements required for health care of Yatries will be in place as per decision.
9. The security forces/other agencies will not write on roads/side stone but can erect banners of their message.
10. The Executive Director, J&K Bank informed that all banking facilities like Extension Counters or ATM facilities will be made available. He informed the chair that till date 7.5 lac Yatries have made their registration.
11. Forest Deptt has been directed to make adequate arrangement of fire wood for the purpose.
12. MD, JKSRTC was directed to make all necessary arrangements for transportation of Sadhus, etc. during Yatra-2016.
13. The DC Anantnag/Ganderbal/other agencies were directed to make fool proof Disaster Management Plans in order tackle any untoward incidents.
14. The DC, Anantnag/Ganderbal shall take follow up meeting with concerned departments in order to evade any lapses with regard to smooth conduct of Amarnath Ji Yatra-2016.

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15. General Manager, BSNL is advised to provide all necessary arrangements with regard to telecommunication in order to avoid any inconvenience to Yatrees during Amarnath Ji Yatra-2016.

16. Director, Tourism, Kashmir was directed to execute works before commencement of Yatra-2016. Besides, other arrangements like providing of tents etc be kept ready as per past precedence.
