After the feedback from all Deputy Commissioners on all above points following directions/instructions were passed:-

1. Arrangements for Eid-i-Milad-un-Nabi 響.

• The chair impressed up on all the Deputy Commissioners to make foolproof arrangements at all the religious place where big congregations will take place on the eve of Ei-i-Milad-un-Nabi . Special focus needs to be given to Asar-i-sharief Hazratbal, Jenab Sahb Soura, Asaar Sharief Kalashpora, Aham Sharief Bandipora, Makhama Beerwa, Kabamara & Kharam-Sirhama and Pinjoora Shopian.

• J&K, Muslim Wakf Board shall make necessary arrangements in and around the shrines within their domain. The necessary arrangements shall include Public information System, Sanitation, Deployment of dedicated staff and installation of CCTV Cameras on identified locations. Also 04 CCTV Cameras on four side of Dargah Sharief Hazratbal shall be installed by Wakf Board for watch and ward purposes.

• CCTV manned by J&K Police inside shrine of Asaar Sharief Hazratbal shall be rechecked and made fully functional well before the Urs days if not so.

(Action by :SP Hazratbal)

 Srinagar Municipal Corporation/Urban Local Bodies shall ensure that sufficient dedicated Safai Karamcharies are deployed at all the identified shrines during the Urs days. Cleanliness drives shall be undertaken there without fail.

(Action by SMC/ULB/Wakf Board)

• PHE, Department shall make sufficient arrangements of drinking water on all the places of main congregations. Besides Tankers service shall also be keep in standby mode.

(Action by : CE PHE/SMC)

 Power Department shall ensure un-interrupted Power supply at all shrines/Mosques during the Urs days. Besides Gen. Sets shall be kept on standby mode to meet any exigency on account of power cuts. All highmast lights /lights shall be made functional before the Urs days.

(Action by PDD/LAWDA/SMC/Wakaf Board)

 Director, Food and Supplies & CA shall ensure availability of sufficient food grains/supplies /LPG. Besides, fire wood shall be made available well in advance at all the identified places.

• Information Department shall ensure installation of proper Public Address System each at Bus Stand, medical Aid Camp, and Police Choki at Hazratbal Shrine.

 Market checking squads and Food Safety Department shall start intense market checking. Strict action shall be taken against black marketers, hoarders and erring shopkeepers as per the law.

 Necessary arrangements of route plans en-route important mosques/shrines especially Dargah Hazratbal shall be made. Parking slots shall be identified and depicted in black and white on roads besides

- Potholes and chocked drains around the shrines and other areas be restored. The road from Saida Kadal to Zindshah Masjid from Dhobighat shall be repaired well before the Urs.

- Fire and emergency services shall ensure availability of sufficient fire tenders at all important shrines and get hydrants audited before the commencement of Urs.

Medical aid camp at Hazratbal Shrine Srinagar shall be established. One
Ambulance shall be kept standby on the gate of Hazratbal Shrine for
convenience of devotees. Doctor and paramedical staff shall also be
deployed at Hazrabal during Urs days. The medical facility shall be made
available at all the places of main congregations on the eve of Urs.

- 2. Observance of Rashtriya Ekta Diwas (National Unity Day) on 31st
 October 2019/ Swearing In Ceremony of BDCs Arrangements thereof.
 - Rashtriya Ekta Diwas (National Unity Day) shall be observed/organized on 31st of October 2019 with full zeal and zest.

(Action by: All Deputy Commissioners/SSPs)

 BDCs swearing in ceremony shall be conducted on the same day preferably at 10.00 AM on the locations already identified by concerned Deputy Commissioners.

 Pledge of Ekta Devas shall follow the swearing in ceremony. Subsequently run for unity shall be conducted by the respective Deputy Commissioners as per the programme they have already chalked out by involving Panches/Sarpanchs/Government Officials/ Traders/ Students/ YSS etc.
