DIVISIONAL COMMISSIONER, KASHMIR, SRINAGAR

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To review the action taken on the directions given by the Hon'ble Governor during the meeting Chaired by the Hon'ble Governor, a meeting was held by Shri Baseer Ahmad Khan, IAS, Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir on 01.07.2018 at 4.00 P.M. at Hari Niwas.

List of the participants of the meeting is annexed as Annexure-A.

The Chair informed that 44 evacuation centres at 35 locations have been notified for District centres. After threadbare discussions, the following directions were issued:-

He shall also provide the locations where refilling of tankers would be done. 7.	VC, LAWDA informed that 114 boats have been dispatched to various locations and 30 more boats have been kept on standby. In addition, 29 boats of SDRF and I&FC departments have been kept on standby. 10.	Installation of High Mast lamps at the camp locations, especially Gogoland. CE, EM&RE apprised the Chair that of high mast lights have been installed at Gogoland camp. Further he apprised that gentsets have been installed at the camp locations. However, MD, JK PCC may be requested to allow PDD to use the generator installed by JK PCC at SPS Library, Srinagar. CE, EM&RE also apprised the Chair that the residents of Maloora are creating a law and order problem against the decision taken by PDD with regard to shifting of load from Bakshipora Receiving Station to Shalteng as 03 no. of electric poles have been damaged.
