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Subject:- District level Meeting on various issues.

A review meeting under the chairmanship of Mr. Baseer Ahmad Khan, IAS, Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir was held on 18.10.2019 at 3.00 PM at Banquet Hall Srinagar regarding the review of developmental schemes/ issues of all sectors of district Srinagar.

Deputy Commissioner Srinagar along with all the District Level officers participated in the meeting.

The meeting focused on the following points.


- i. Holding of Gram Sabhas.
- ii. Status of Rs. 5.00 Crores released under Back to Village programme.
- iii. Status of opening /Operation of accounts of Panches/Sarpanches.
- iv. Status of issuance of Weaker Section Certificates.
- v. Monitoring of various programmes under languishing projects.
- vi. Position of essential supplies.
- vii. Functioning of Schools/hospitals/offices.
- viii. Model village in tribal areas.
- ix. Mapping out of details of Land Bank State/Kacharai to be utilized for various projects especially for Industrial ventures and Industrial estates.
- x. Status of PMGSY cases.

At the outset the chair sought feedback on above points and accordingly discussed with the officers of Departments/agencies viz, Education, Health, PHE/Electricity/R&B, CA&PD, SMC, YSS, IOC, HPCL, SICOP, Social Welfare, Horticulture, Agriculture etc and issued necessary directions to the concerned officers for smooth functioning and early completion of the works in a time bound manner. The works on the languishing projects shall be completed/resumed immediately after exploring the possibilities of engaging the local labour. Besides, the officers should reach out to the public/ villages, listen their grievances and utilize resources to mitigate their problems. All the officers/officials shall ensure their availability to the public and shall live up to their aspirations.

The Deputy Commissioner, Srinagar welcomed the Chair and gave a power point presentation about the achievements made with regard to the agenda points and developmental scenario in district Srinagar as under:-

After brief interaction with the Deputy Commissioner and his team of officers on the agendas, following decisions/instructions were passed as shown below :-

<p>Holding of Gram Sabhas. It was informed that Rs 245.41 lacs stand already credited in the respective accounts under 14th F.C. Two Gram Sabhas are being organized in all four blocks of District on monthly basis. Moreover, to publicize about Swatch Bharat Abhiyaan, Gram Sabhas Schedules have already been devised which have started from 2nd October 2019 to 31st December 2019</p>	<p>The Divisional Commissioner directed to the concerned department and also to Deputy Commissioner to hold Gram Sabhas and utilize the funds provided for identifying the community works based on felt requirements of particular area. Regarding Swatch Bharat Abhiyaan the chair instructed to launch the intensive drive on regular basis in the district by involving various stake holders, traders, students Panchayats and Urban Local Bodies. Regarding no first use of plastic effective means need to employed to bring down the incidence of use of plastic. Sanitation drive also needs to be undertaken to ensure that water bodies and banks of rivers are kept clean and no littering is allowed in these areas.</p>
<p>Status of issuance of Weaker Section Certificates. It was apprised that 276 certificates have been issued to the weaker sections of the society by the concerned Tehsildars till date as per the circular No. 19-GAD dated 30.03.2019 and SRO-518 dated 02.09.2019 issued by Social Welfare Department</p>	<p>The special camps shall be organized for speedy verification process for issuance of weaker section certificates to the eligible beneficiaries in a time bound manner in pursuance to the instructions laid in Circular No:-19-GAD of 2019 dated:- 30/03/2019 issued by GAD. Regarding assistance of post matric and ISS scholarship schemes, the chair intimated that assistance has been credited to their accounts for which awareness needs to be generated to enable beneficiaries to draw the same.</p>
<p>Status of Rs. 5.00 Crores released under Back to Village programme. That an amount of Rs 5.00 Crores has been released by the Finance deptt. for</p>	<p>The process of accord of administrative approval shall be completed within one week. Besides, the process shall be monitored minutely.</p>


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<p>during the Back to Village Programme held from 20/06/2019 to 27/06/2019 in 21 Panchayat Halqas of the District. The process of accord of AAA is at its final stage.</p>	
<p>Status of opening /Operation of accounts of Panches/Sarpanches. The bank accounts for all the Panchayats have been opened as joint accounts in the name of concerned VLW/Sarpanch and VLW/Administrator in elected and non elected Panchayats respectively.</p>	<p>The chair express satisfaction on the issue.</p>
<p>Position of essential supplies. The chair was apprised that for the months of August, September & Oct; 2019, 220204.65 Quintals of food grains have been distributed in Srinagar. Besides, sufficient stock of food grains, petroleum products and medicines are available in the district.</p>	<p>All the Departments, viz, Food CS & CA/Gas/Oil Companies etc , shall ensure the maximum top-up of stock capacity of the essential commodities/supplies is available in view of ensuing winter season so that the public may not suffer.</p> <p>The chair directed all the concerned departments to be ready with the winter preparedness plan/resources as already directed in the calendar of activities separately chalked out for each district. Heating arrangements for Hospitals, machinery for snow clearance operations and manpower should remain alert to undertake the task assigned to each at the spur moment. He also directed that winter control rooms shall be established at the district headquarter w.e.f 25.10.2019.</p>
<p>Functioning of Schools/hospitals/offices. It was apprised that on an average 80.75% of the staff and 23.30% of students remained present in schools. Besides all the health institutions in the district are functioning and 98% staff remained present in other offices.</p>	<p>The chair directed that 100% attendance of employees be ensured in the offices/schools/hospitals and the action against the absentees without bonafide reasons shall be initiated immediately by the concerned officers. The report in this regard shall be submitted by the concerned officers to Deputy Commissioner on daily basis for its onward submission to the Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir.</p>

Model Village. Under the scheme Special Central Assistance to Tribal Sub Scheme (SCA to TSS), 02 Cluster Model Villages namely Faqir Gujree "A" & Faqir Gujree "B" and Astanpora Khimber of District Srinagar have been identified to be developed as Cluster Tribal Model Villages during 2019-20. The DPRs /Action Plan is being submitted to the higher authorities for approval. Out of 4.85 lacs target of beneficiaries in the District Srinagar 79316 have been verified and 68272 have been approved

to the higher authorities for approval within one week.

Mapping out of details of Land Bank State/Kacharai to be utilized for various projects especially for Industrial ventures and Industrial estates. It was appraised that out of 31972.13 Kanals of land 12066.12 kanals have been illegally encroached out of which 1555.10 Kanals have been retrieved.


The work with regard to mapping out of details of land bank state/kacharai shall be completed within in 15 days so that it can be utilized for establishment of various projects/schemes viz, industrial estates, play fields, schools, colleges etc. The process of removal of encroachment shall be speeded.

Status of PMGSY cases. It was appraised that three projects have been identified under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana to provide connectivity to unconnected Habitations of following five villages :-

1. Construction of Nagbal Dardkhwar Road(Dara).
2. Construction of road from Khimber to Takiya Sangreshi.
3. Construction of road from New Theed to Mulnar (stage-I).

The amount of compensation of amount of Rs.59.89 Lacs has been received for only Construction of road from Khimber to Takiya Sangreshi out of which Rs.11.80 lacs has been disbursed. The funds for remaining project have not yet been released.

The remaining work shall be completed within two weeks after following all the codal formalities.


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Monitoring of various programmes under languishing projects. In total 93 languishing projects were approved for the following departments against the total approved cost of Rs. 883.64 Crores, the high level Committee have approved the balance amount of Rs 399.62 Crores required for completion of the said projects is given as Annexure "B".

A time line with regard to completion of languishing projects shall be drawn and shall be intensively monitored by the Deputy Commissioner and in this regard inter departmental teams shall be constituted. In case there is dearth of skilled labourers, same shall be intimated. Divisional Administration shall explore the possibilities of arranging the skilled labourers from outside state for which they shall be provided camp site accommodation on the pattern of District Bandipora/Kupwara.

The chair appreciated the efforts being put in place by the Deputy Commissioner/SSP Srinagar after the 5th of August 2019.


Before culminating the meeting the chair was pleased to pass the following directions/instructions in addition to the agenda points placed by the District Administration Srinagar.

- Off line mode of disbursement in all the Health Institutions / Hospitals shall be adopted for Ayushman Bharat Scheme till the internet facility is restored in the Valley.
- The drive with regard to removal of encroachments (if any) shall be intensified by the Revenue authorities without any further delay.
- All the departments viz, R&B/ PHE/ PDD/ UEED /SMC / Mechanical Engineering etc shall complete the winter preparedness with immediate effect pertaining to their departments to ensure the redressal of public difficulties during winter in a time bound manner. In this connection the Mechanical Engineer department shall establish control room & make the snow clearance of roads as per the past practice. PDD department shall ensure the buffer stock of transformers. PHE department will make the arrangements supply of safe drinking water through tankers where the need arises during the winter.
- The District administration shall make the necessary security/transport plan for smooth conduct and completion of upcoming Board examinations strictly as per the directions given in the meeting of Deputy Commissioners.
- The PDD department will complete the necessary branch cutting by 25th of October, 2019 positively.


- The requisite formalities for establishment of proposed Colleges at Nowgam shall be completed within 15 days.
- The Deputy Commissioner shall constitute teams for inspecting Anganwadi Centres and old age homes.
- The District administration will take immediate necessary steps for removal of critical bottlenecks especially in down town area.
- The District administration shall include the concept of bus stop near schools under smart school programme of SADP to encourage the public for including the said idea for other schools in the district. The District administration will also take the necessary steps for establishing craft clusters/market on craft-wise basis like Zainakadal and old silk factory areas where land is available.
- The concerned departments will project the liability list with District Dev. Commissioner including the liabilities against the Moharram and Yatra etc. immediately before the Darbar Move so that the matter is taken up with the Government well in time.
- The acquisition process for removal of shops around Khan-kahi Moulla Shrine for its expansion and beautification shall be started immediately.
- The concerned departments/executing agencies shall submit the pending estimates of proposed works and initiate the execution of works after fulfillment of all codal formalities to ensure that the benefits of scheme are reached to the real beneficiaries as per the guidelines.
- The Chair directed that the executing agencies shall submit letter of commitment on account of various road cuts under the languishing projects only to the R&B department who shall issue NOC for the road cuts to the concerned executing agencies, after completing all codal formalities so that the execution of languishing projects will not hamper for the said purpose.
- The youth engagement programmes viz, organizing sports tournaments, awareness camps with regard to drug menace/schemes of social welfare/NABARD/ etc shall be conducted at the tehsil/block/panchayat level.
- The District Administration shall take immediate steps for early vacation of the status co for early resumption of work for extension of Noor khana, Peer Dastgeer Sahib Shrine executed by JKPCC.


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- The land available/ adjacent to the schools be developed for providing play fields in the panchayats where there is no land available for the purpose.
- The fabricated sheds for the establishment of Dry Fruit Mandi shall be constructed within 20 days.
- The PDD officials /officers shall reach out to the public and detailed report shall be submitted with regard to deficiency/need of transformers or any other issue in order to meet out the crises especially in winter season.

The Chair appreciated the dedication rendered by Health institutions viz, SKIMS/GMC Srinagar/ Health Services etc and officers/officials of the District/Police Administration during the current prevailing circumstances.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to and from the Chair.
