**After threadbare discussion and deliberations following directions were passed: -**

1.	Drinking Water/ Sewerage Issues at Railway Station Budgam	PHE Department shall explore the possibility of providing Tap water at Railway Station Budgam on top priority. Municipal Committee, Budgam shall explore the possibility of providing facility of garbage collection to Budgam Railway Colony and Station at prevailing rates provided the garbage is collected and segregated at the source itself. Besides, Railway Department shall submit a written requisition to this office with regard to Solid waste plant for which Deputy Commissioner, Budgam shall identify a suitable land near railway station. Drinking water issue at Railway Station Qazigund	The chair was apprised that the locals/villagers have shown resentment over the laying of pipe line from Hiller to Railway Station Qazigund, as 2.5 kms pipe line has been laid down out of 3.00 kms. 3.	<b>Unauthorized occupation of railway residential quarters at various Railway stations.</b>	While deliberating on the issue, the chair impressed upon the railway authorities to submit the minimum requirement of quarters need to be taken back to this office for the residential purpose of officials of Railway so that matter is to be taken up with security forces viz, Army, CRPF, etc for its early retrieval. For rest of the quarters which will be held by security forces, rent as per prevailing rates shall be raised by Railway authorities and subsequently paid by concerned agency. Moreover, the presence of the security forces at railway stations are badly required for the security purposes.	<b>CAM/SINA Railways</b>
4.	<b>Unauthorized occupation and construction of structures by CRPF at Railway station Sadura.</b>	The chair directed that CRPF shall immediately stop the unauthorized encroachment and also shall desist from making concrete structures in future. Besides, remove the unauthorized concrete structures forthwith.	<b>IG CRPF Ops/</b>
5.	<b>Inconvenience being faced by staff families of Railway at Kakapora Station by SOG Camp.</b>	The chair directed that SOG at the camp shall restrict their movement so that no inconvenience is felt by the families of railway staff members at Kakapora. Besides, possibility shall be explored that a separate in/out & boundary wall is constructed so that privacy of the families is ensured.	<b>IGP Kashmir/S SP Pulwama/S SP Cargo/ CAM/SINA Railways</b>
6.	<b>FOB provided over Lidder River as approach to Railway guest House at Pahalgam got washed away during floods</b>	The chair desired that Railway authorities shall moot a letter to this office for construction of foot over bridge as well as repair of existing building/rest house so Chief Executive Officer, Pahalgam Development Authority is directed to resolve this issue. Furthermore, as informed by DRM, Railways Ferozpur that a patch of land adjacent to Railway Guest house Pahalgam belongs to Railways. It was desired that DRM Railways may furnish revenue papers of the land so that title of land is sorted out and taken up with the concerned quarter for its resolution.	<b>CAM/SINA Railways</b>




7.	Payment on a/c of private land compensation in Srinagar.	The DRM Ferozpur. Informed that the issue with regard to the subject matter is not dealt by him, instead it is being looked by Dy. Railway Manager USBRL. The chair directed that matter shall be taken up with them for its early release of payment.	Dy. Manager USBRL/ ACC
