Sub: Minutes of the meeting held under the chairmanship of Divisional Commissioner Kashmir on 24-02-2018 in connection with various issues related to Hazrat Sultan-ul-Arifeen village Tujjar Sharief (Zaingair) Baramulla.

A meeting under the chairmanship of Divisional Commissioner Kashmir was convened on **24-02-2018** in connection with the subject hereinabove.

At the outset, the chair welcomed all the participants and appreciated the efforts put in by the local inhabitants and managers of Ziyarat Tujar Sharief in their endeavors. During the meeting, the Chairman Makhdoom Trust apprised the various issues faced thereon.

After having threadbare discussions with all the concerned Heads/Representatives of departments, the following decisions were taken:-

1. Chief Engineer, PHE informed the chair that Project Report of Rupees 9. 90 crores have already been formulated and work has been started which can solve the problem of filtration plant

and pumping station. Chief Engineer, PHE was directed to keep the sizable budget for the scheme during the financial year 2018-2019.

2. Director Tourism informed the chair that a DPR for reconstruction of Ziyarat Sharif has been formulated which shall cost around rupees 3.36 crores. The chair directed that the tenders should float immediately and the work should be started within next 20 days.

3. PDD has already informed that a DPR to the tune of Rupees 354.00 lacs has been prepared which shall establish 6.3 KVA receiving station. The chair directed the department to submit the same to the Administrative Department and the tenders in this regard shall be floated within one week so that the work shall be started within one month.

4. The Director Health department was directed to examine the demands for establishment of medical block at Tujar Shairef and submit the feasibility report to the Government for further necessary action.

5. The Chief Engineer R&B Department was directed to macadamize the links in the month of May 2018 for which pre-macadamized works have already been done.

(Action by: Chief Engineer, PWD (R&B), KMR)

6. General Manager State Bank of India was directed to provide the Customer Service Point at Tujar Sharief before the 31st March 2018.

(Action by: General Manager State Bank of India)

7. Deputy Commissioner Baramulla will send a team of Revenue Officers to rectify the errors in the settlement of land records and submit the rectified report to this office within one week for further necessary action.

(Action by: Deputy Commr. Baramulla).



8. Director Libraris will pursue the proposal for establishment of Library at Tujar Sharief and shall submit the proposal to the Administrative Department for furtherance.

(Action by: Director Libraries, KMR)

9. Director School Education will depute a team to Tujar Sharief and submit the report regarding the demand of shifting of Government Middle School Tujar Sharief to any other suitable place.

(Action by: Director Education, KMR)

10. Director Rural Development Department will depute concerned District Panchayat Officer to visit the area and submit a report regarding execution of Rural Development works and new proposed works to be taken up by the Department, in consultation with Ziyarat Management.

(Action by: Director RDD, KMR)

11. Chief Engineer, Irrigation and Flood Control will examine the works on development of Lal Koul Irrigation canal and submit a report to this office in this regard.

(Action by: Chief Engineer, I&FC, KMR)

12. Deputy Commissioner, Baramulla shall convene a meeting with the line departments and submit Action Taken Report with regard to the decisions taken in this meeting.
