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After threadbare discussion and deliberations following decisions were taken:

I. Arrangements for Holy Month of Ramdan-ul Mubarak-1442.

1.	Availability of Ration/K.Oil/LPG/Atta/Sugar etc.	The chair while apprised by the Director FCS&CA, Kashmir that 70% for the month of April 2021 ration has been dispatched was directed that 100% ration distribution shall be ensured by or before 13.04.2021 positively and without any fail. Besides, ration supply for the month of April shall be distributed within time. Moreover, the general public shall not face any kind of problems on account of essential commodities during the month of Ramadan.	Director FCS&CA
2.	Market Checking Teams	The chair directed that inter departmental teams of Revenue, Police, FCS&CA, Legal Metrology, Food & Safety, SMC/ULB etc shall be constituted well before the commencement of Holy Month of Ramadaan to curb the menace of black marketing, profiteering etc at the District, Sub-district and Tehsil/block levels. Besides, rigorous market checking drives shall be conducted on peak hours of marketing viz, morning /evening and any body found violating the norms/rates shall be strictly dealt as per the provisions of law governing the subject. Further, Dy. Commissioner, Food & Safety Kashmir was directed convey strict message to Food Inspectors & other officers to conduct the meticulous market checking viz quality of products and the action taken shall be given wide publicity through media and social media so that violators will not dare to any wrong doing. 3.	Power Supply	The chair directed that PDD shall ensure continuous power supply especially during the peak times of Sehri and Iftari (early morning & evening). Besides, the damaged transformers shall be repaired and re-installed well before the commencement of Ramadan ul Mubarak 2021. It was further, directed that restoration of	CE KPDCL Kmr. Cont. LMD

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		transformers shall be done within shortest time as compared to winter. Besides, the schedule for month of Ramzaan shall be issued and published immediately.	
4.	Availability of Water supply	The chair directed that sufficient and quality water shall be made available to the public during the month especially at the time of Sehri and Ifari. Besides, portable water shall be made available to the public where there is needed.	CE PHE, Kmr.
5.	Availability of Transport	RTO Kashmir and GM SRTC Kashmir shall ensure that sufficient No. of busses/commercial vehicles are plying on the roads during the whole month especially after evening hours.	RTO kmr/ GM SRTC kmr.
6.	Parking of vehicles	SSP Traffic Rural Kashmir and SSP, Traffic SSP Srinagar shall ensure sufficient parking space during the whole month and particularly during the prayers. Besides, rigorous drives/checking shall be conducted to ensure and stop overcharging/exorbitant charging by the transports. Any body found violating the fare rate list shall be booked as per rules governing the subject.	SSP Traffic Sgr/Riral kmr. RTO Kashmir.
7.	Sanitation Drive/ functioning of street lights.	SMC/ULB shall ensure intensive sanitation drives well before the start of the holy month of Ramzaan at the main religious places in Srinagar and other districts respectively. Further, SMC shall constitute a team of officers for checking /testing the functioning of street lights & identification of dark spots in the Srinagar City. The report in this regard shall be submitted to this within 04 days, besides, it shall be ensured that all street lights/dark spots are covered before the commencement of Ramadaan ul Mubarak 2021. Similarly, ULB shall ensure functioning of all street lights in the MCs well before 13.04.2021.	Com. SMC/Dir. ULB
8.	Security Arrangements	Special arrangements of security shall be put in place by Police and security forces through the Kashmir Valley.	IGP Kmr/SSP Sec. kmr.
9.	Repair of Roads	R&B Department shall ensure identification and filling of pot holes on the roads/ways leading to the main venues of congregation well before 13.04.2021.	CE R&B kmr.

10.	Availability of Meat/ chicken and other items in Market.	Director, Sheep Husbandry Kashmir while apprising the chair informed that 7000 sheep will be made available by the Department to the butchers during the month of Ramzaan was directed to ensure that sufficient No. of quality sheep are available in the market. Besides, Director Animal Husbandry was directed that it shall be ensured that infected birds are not allowed to enter to valley. Further, it shall be ensured that all the precautionary measures /Covid-19 SOPs have been taken by the butchers/sellers.	Dir. FCS&CA/S heep Husbandry/ Animal Husbandry.
11.	Following of Covid-19 SOPs during the prayers.	The chair directed that Wakaf Board shall ensure that all the covid-19 SOPs are followed in the masjids controlled by Wakaf Board. Besides, Honorary Secretary Red Cross Kashmir shall issue red cross receipt books to wakaf board for imposition of fine to the persons violating the covid-19 norms in the masjids. Further, masks shall be made available to the people visiting the masjids for prayers. Health Facilities	Health Services Kashmir shall impart necessary instructions / directions to the generabl public for following the covid-19 SOPs/Guidelines during the month of Ramzaan especially during the praying times. 
I. Arrangements for the celebration of Navratra, 2021


