Subject: Revenue Officers Meeting.

The Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir, Shri Pandurang K. Pole, IAS, chaired a maiden meeting of Revenue Officers of Kashmir Division on 29.07.2020. At the outset of the very exhaustive and comprehensive review, the chair informed the participants that as Deputy Commissioners, remains involved with the works of other departments thereby the revenue related works get neglected and impressed upon that revenue related works shall be accorded 1st priority in all circumstances. He further, informed that regional (South/Central/North) monthly revenue meetings shall be taken by him for which a fixed date shall be communicated. Besides, he impressed upon the Deputy Commissioners to spare the Assistant Commissioner, Revenue of their respective districts only for the revenue related works.

Bandipora: Deputy Commissioner, Bandipora was directed to submit the case with regard to Degree College Tulail within 03 days for the land measuring 50-60 k only. He was further, directed to submit the case of Degree College Hajain after completion of all codal formalities within one week.

Baramulla: Deputy Commissioner, Baramulla was directed to submit the revenue papers clearly indicating that 60 k for GDC Bonyar and 40 k for Stadium have been identified separately & complete in all respects. Further, he was directed to furnish the revenue papers of land measuring 48k & 19M (recorded as Kacharia) identified for GDC Thindem along with the certificate /clarification that no compensation has been paid as the same was earlier part of the acquisition also. Moreoever, the land in question is required to be de-notified out of acquired land measuring 123k and 15 marlas by the Govt.

Ganderbal: Deputy Commissioner, Ganderbal was asked that the clarification report with regard to GDC Gund is yet to be received which shall be submitted within one week. Moreover, proprietary land measuring 2k & 4 m coming under the alignment shall be either separated if falling on aside or to be exchanged if coming within the alignment.

Kulgam: The chair was apprised that village Frisal falls in the close vicinity of village Yaripora and it was decided in the Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor visit that the Degree College shall be constructed in Yaripora and a Professional College to be constructed at Frisal. Deputy Commissioner, was directed to take up the matter with Technical Education Department before proceeding ahead in the matter.

Kupwara: Deputy Commissioner, was directed to submit the cases of GDC Kralpora and Langate to this office duly completed in all respect within one week's time.

Pulwama: Deputy Commissioner, was directed to submit the case with regard to GDC Rajpora complete in all respect within week's time.

Shopian: The Deputy Commissioner informed that case with regard to sanction of college at Zainapora & Wachi was pending disposal before the Hon'ble High
