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Subject: Record Note of meeting held on 28-04-2018 regarding streamlining of traffic system in Kashmir Valley.

A meeting under the Chairmanship of Divisional Commissioner Kashmir was convened on **28-04-2018 at 03. 00 PM** in order to streamline traffic system in Kashmir Valley.

Following officers attended the meeting:

7. President/Representative, Bus Association/Sumo Stand Association/Tippers/Auto Rickshaw Association.

At the outset, the Divisional Commissioner Kashmir advised all ARTO's/chairmen of various transport Associations who were present in the meeting to adhere to the following instructions in letter and spirit without fail & in case anybody will be found violating these instructions, strict action shall be taken against them. Representatives of various Transport agencies from all districts put forth their issues before the chair and the Chair gave on spot directions to the concerned for their redressal:

1. Over loading shall be avoided.
2. Ladies seats to be kept available for ladies only & shall not be occupied by gents.
3. All drives and conductors shall use uniform within five days.
4. Discount for students in bus fare to be provided.
5. Auto Rickshaws shall ensure installation of meters and adhere to the rate list.
6. No use of Music system/CD players in passenger motor vehicles.
7. Use of Cell phones during driving will not be allowed.

8. Avoid haphazard parking.
9. Tippers to use tarpaulin cover on the carriage material.
10. Rate lists in passenger vehicles to be published and pasted on each and every passenger vehicle.
11. No passenger vehicle shall ply for schools.
12. All Deputy Commissioners have been directed to nominate Naib Tehsildars/BDO's to check these rules in their respective areas.
13. Chief Engineer, PWD (R & B) Kashmir will improve deteriorated road condition particularly Beeru-Budgam road.
14. RTO Kashmir shall examine the case of Sumo Drivers Association Budgam for proving space around LD hospital for pick and drop only and submit report within fifteen days.
15. Implementation of colour code by the notified taxi Sumo Stands immediately.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks from the chair.
