Minutes of the meeting held under the Chairmanship of Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir on 27.02.2018 regarding implementation

A meeting under the Chairmanship of Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir was held on 27.02.2018 at 3.00 P.M. regarding implementation of State Water Policy.

All the Deputy Commissioners of Kashmir Division except Deputy Commissioner, Srinagar participated in the meeting through Video Conference, However, the officers from Jammu who were supposed to participate in the meeting through Video Conferencing could not participate due to some technical

List of the participants who attended the meeting is enclosed as Annexure-A.

At the outset, the Chair impressed upon the Officers that initiatives shall be taken to conserve the water bodies whether falling within the demarcated forest area or beyond the boundaries of forest area as they are prone to different onslaughts both due to human intervention like encroachments, deforestation, contamination, etc. and due to natural disasters like landslides, vagaries of nature e.g. loss in the water table due to low rainfall, etc. He asked them to collect data by way of mapping down of forest areas, mapping down areas of the water bodies, both superficial and ground water, within and outside the forest areas; ascertain their present status vis-à-vis their peripheral area, status about their shrinkage/expansion, capacity, usage, quality of water, factors responsible for its contamination, measures employed to achieve its purity, measures to be taken to ensure to get it to its original status, etc. He impressed upon the Officers Forest, 1&FC, PHE departments to share the data on the subject with the respective Deputy Commissioners so that it is dovetailed with the data collected by the District Level teams which would exactly help in finding out the capacity/usage/discharge and other parameters of each water body including river/nallah/tributary/stream, etc. However, it was pointed out that contamination of water bodies is mainly due to draining of untreated sewerage waste of the human habitations residing near to them. Conservation and protection measures to be taken shall also be reflected in the report. The data collected shall be evaluated and physically seeing/verifying it. He further impressed upon them to

Representative from University of Kashmir apprised the Chair that mapping of the water bodies has already been done in the year 2010 and the data formulated would form the basis for the present survey/census.

Chief Engineer, PHE, Kashmir apprised the Chair that a Plan has been formulated to overcome the scarcity of water during summer and will be
