# Subject:- Minutes of meeting regarding the pending NOCs of Mining Leases in respect of District Baramulla and Pulwama.

Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir took a meeting with regard to subject matter on **09.07.2021** in meeting hall of this office.

At the outset, the chair while welcomed was informed that out of 38 e-auctioned minor mineral blocks in Baramulla, NOCs for 33 blocks through Distt. Level Single Window System Committee is issued, however, NOCs for 5 blocks have not been issued due to denial / reservation from stake holder departments. In respect of District Pulwama the chair was further informed that out of total 38 e-auctioned minor mineral blocks, NOCs for only 18 blocks have been issued through District Level Sngle Window Committee and NOCs for remaining 20 blocks have not been issued due to denial/reservation from stake holder departments.
