Subject:- Meeting to review the status of developmental works and difficulties being faced while executing them.

A meeting under the chairmanship of Mr. Baseer Ahmad Khan, IAS, Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir was held on 31.08.2019 at 03.00 PM regarding the status of developmental works and difficulties being faced in executing these works.

Following officers participated in the meeting:-

- 1. Deputy Commissioner, Srinagar.
- 2. Director Rural Development.
- 3. Chief Engineer, PDD along with Supdtt. Engineer, Srinagar.
- 4. Chief Engineer, Systems & Operations along with Supdtt. Engineer.
- 5. Chief Engineer, Generations along with Supdtt. Engineer.
- 6. Chief Engineer, PW (R&B) along with Supdtt. Engineer.
- 7. Chief Engineer, PHE along with Supdtt. Engineer.

The meeting focused on the following points.

- 1. Immediately get in touch with the executing agencies and submit feedback with regard to start of works.
- 2. Chalking out calendar of start of work indicating exact requirement of resources.
- 3. Exploring the possibilities of engaging the local labourers for resumption of works.
- 4. Communication with M/S: SIEMENS & SIMPLEX for resuming of works.
- 5. Restoration of Inter-grid communication.
- 6. Floating / uploading of Tender documents.
- 7. Exploring the possibilities of getting in touch with the outside skilled labourers for resumption of works through the contractors.

At the outset, the Chair sought feedback with regard to start of works from the departments and enquired about the problems being faced while resuming the works.

The Chair stressed that works should be started by exploring the possibilities of engaging local labourers if the outside labour is not available. Besides, the contractors from outside the State be contacted and asked to resume the work for which assurance shall be given to them that they will be provided full support viz. boarding and lodging at the site of work with necessary measures for safe stay in case they feel threatened.

The Chair was appraised by the officers that due to exodus of skilled labour and non-availability of mobile phone facilities, the departments are unable to communicate to the sub offices/divisions for any feedback/progress. Besides, the contractors are also unable to respond to the tenders floated by the departments through NIC and sought exemption/revision of E-tendering.

The Chief Engineer, PDD along with Supdtt. Engineer, Srinagar appraised the chair the revenues are being normally collected, besides, some of the maintenance works are being executed at several sites. Chief Engineer, Systems and Operations Kashmir appraised that their workshops are functioning round the clock where repairs/maintenance of transforms are being carried out normally and during the last two weeks 76 Transformers have been repaired/maintained in these workshops at Srinagar. Chief Engineer, PHE, Kashmir submitted that the department is managing the operation of water supply normally to the whole valley. Besides, various works are going on in Handwara/Kupwara and about 700 works in the valley are in ppipeline shall be resumed in a week or ten days.

The Director, Rural Development Kashmir appraised the chair that works which were suspended have now started although not at full scale in various panchayats and requested for off-line transactions through NIC. Chief Engineer, Irrigation, Flood & Control appraised the chair that the works are in progress in Mohar Nalla, Nalla, Kelri Ladder Nalla, Lolab, Shopian, Kangan Kupwara/Handwara. Besides, the department intend to start the dredging work at Hokarsar for which the clearance is pending and in this regard the matter needs to be taken up with the Regional Wildlife Warden Kashmir. The Chief Engineer, R&B Kashmir appraised that some interior works at SMHS Hospital are going on. Besides, some minor works are being carried out at many places and there is much availability of material.

After threadbare discussions, following decisions were taken:
