Minutes of the meeting held under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister for Department of Disaster Management, Relief, Rehabilitation & Reconstruction, J&K on 08-02-2018 in connection with celebration of Maha-Shivratri.

A meeting under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister for Department of Disaster Management, Relief, Rehabilitation & Reconstruction, J&K was held on 08/02/2018 in the meeting hall of Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir in connection with the celebration of Maha-Shivratri in which besides Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir, the following officers attended the meeting:

At the very outset the Chair sought feedback about the arrangements made in connection with celebration of Maha Shivratri. After threadbare discussions, the following decisions were taken:-

1. Chief Engineer, PHE, Kashmir will make necessary arrangements for providing drinking water facilities in the areas of pandits and migrant camp sites on the eve of Mahashivratri. He shall also keep on stand-by tankers to supplement the requirement in case of any disruption in the piped water supply.

(Action by: Chief Engineer, PHE, Kmr)

2. Chief Engineer, PDD, Kashmir will make necessary arrangements for uninterrupted power supply in the areas of pandits and migrant camp sites on the eve of Mahashivratri. He shall also keep on stand-by DG sets at the places/temples where congregations will be held to supplement the requirement in case of any disruption in power supply.

(Action by: Chief Engineer, PDD, Kmr)

3. Director, Health Services, Kashmir will make necessary arrangements of healthcare/medical checkup camps in the areas of migrants and also in camp sites during Mahashivratri days.

(Action by: Dir. Health Services, Kmr)

4. Joint Director, Fisheries, Kashmir will ensure availability of various species of quality fish, in sufficient quantity, at concerned District Headquarters and other areas of migrants. (Action by: JD, Fisheries, Kmr)

5. Deputy Director, Horticulture Planning & Marketing, Kashmir will ensure availability of dry fruits especially quality grade walnuts, almonds, etc in the areas of migrant colonies and also on camp sites on the eve of Mahashivratri. Besides, he will prepare gift packs of quality grade walnuts for free distribution among the pandits, as a goodwill gesture and distribute them among the Hindu community in consultation with the concerned Deputy Commissioners. However, the Hon'ble Minister agreed to provide funds on this account to Deputy Director, Horticulture, (P&M), Kashmir who shall be the Nodal Officer for this assignment.

(Action by: DCs/Dy. Dir., HPM, Kmr)

6. Director, Food, Civil Supplies & CA Department, Kashmir shall ensure availability of quality grade Nadru at reasonable rates in the areas where pundits are residing and in migrant colonies. Besides, he will ensure availability of food grains, sugar, k. oil and LPG to the pundits.

(Action by: Dir. Food, CS &CAD, Kmr)

7. Commissioner, Srinagar Municipal Corporation, Srinagar shall ensure special sanitization drive at the places/temples, especially Hari Parbat Temple, Shankaracharya Temple, etc where congregation will be held. (Action by: Commr, SMC)

8. Director, Urban Local Bodies, Kashmir shall issue necessary instructions to the Executive Officers of Municipal Committees to ensure special sanitization drive at the places/temples located in Municipal Committee limits where congregation will be held. (Action by: Dir. ULB, Kmr) 9. Director, Rural Dev. Department, Kashmir shall issue necessary instructions to the ACDs/BDOs to ensure special sanitization drive at the places/temples located in villages where congregation will be held.

(Action by: Dir. RDD, Kmr)

10. Fool proof security arrangements shall be made by Police at the places/ Temples where congregations will be held.

(Action by: IGP(ADGP), Kmr)

11. Deputy Commissioners/District Magistrates shall deploy Magistrates at the places/temples where congregations will be held. Besides, DCs shall ensure establishment of helpline numbers in their offices and these helpline numbers shall be given wide publicity through print and electronic media. They are also directed to make necessary security and other required arrangements on the occasion.
