At the outset, the chair welcomed and impressed the participants that immediate steps and concrete efforts need to be taken for putting in place the facilities like Slaughter Houses, Solid Waste Management Plants and parks etc for the general public in Srinagar City and the Towns of Kashmir Division.

In case the identified land is kachari land then papers in this regard shall be submitted within week positively. Further, in order to cater the rush of sewage/garbage disposal on scientific pattern during the peak tourist season, Tourism Department shall identify suitable patch of land for the purpose within one week. The chair before directing 07 Deputy Commissioners to switch off from the meeting impressed all the participants to ensure that:-

• The pending revenue papers duly authenticated/transferred in respect of the sites identified for the use of ULB/Parks & Gardens are handed over to the Executive Officer, MC/ Parks & Gardens Officer by

Tehsildar concerned immediately for further course of action by ULB Distt. Admn.

- The land for the transit accommodation for migrants from the pending districts shall be identified within 07 days and papers in this regard shall be submitted within another three days positively.
- The land for the construction of accommodation for PRIs/protected persons shall be identified and transferred in favor of Rural Dev. Department immediately, in-case of state land papers shall be also submitted at an earliest. Besides, the DPR shall be finalized and submitted immediately.
- The districts who have failed to identify the land for Cattle ponds, for Deptt. of Animal Husbandry shall ensure that land for the purpose is identified within couple of days positively without any further delay.

Thereafter, the chair took the review meeting with regard to transfer of land parcels falling under the jurisdiction of District Srinagar, Budgam and Ganderbal to SDA for development of affordable house. The chair was appraised about the action taken of the directions passed in the meeting held under his chairmanship on 28.06. 2021. After, reviewing the ATR, the chair directed as unde:-
