Subject:- Minutes of meeting held under the chairmanship of Divisional Commissioner Kashmir regarding preservation and beautification of wet lands.

Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir chaired meeting with regard to subject matter on 10.04.2021 in meeting hall of this office.

At the outset the chair while welcomed all the participants was apprised by Deputy Commissioner, Bandipora that 85% demarcation of the wet land has been completed and only 15% area is left out. Besides, 34 Hectors are under encroachment at Sher Colony at Sopora Baramulla side and Kanyari Bandipora side. Kanyari Bandipora has been rehabilitated as make shift arrangements for those people who have been relocated during the floods. Plantation has also been removed.

It has been further apprised that sewerage waste management has been relocated but area is still only 01 Kms away from banks of Wullar. A DPR for Rs. 9.00 lacs has been framed by WUCMA on scientific pattern and submitted to Govt. for approval. Moreover, a separate DPR stands framed a

submitted to Govt, but funds have not been released by Housing & Urban Dev. Deptt.

CED, WUCMA apprised the chair that Wullar Boulevard will be done by the PWD as conveyed by the Commissioner Secretary to Govt. PW(R&B) Deptt. and they are conducting site visit.

Poaching of Birds in Wullar	DC Bandipora while apprising the chair that the issue with regard poaching of birds need to be settled as the concerned departments are coordinating and are shifting their responsibilities on wild life Department, the chair directed that Wild Life Warden Hokersar shall act upon the issue strictly as per the standing norms and violators shall be severely punished. Hokersar Wetland	DC Budgam informed the chair that demarcation of two villages have been completed and rest stands halted as the records of two more villages have been seized by the ACB, the chair directed that Xerox copy of same shall be got from ACB and work shall be started. 

5.	Narkara Wet land	DC Budgam apprised that demarcation has been completed, the chair directed that I&FC Department will erect the poles on the boundary of Rakh Arth.	CE I&FC

Anchar Lake	Tehsildar Eidgah Srinagar apprised the chair that 14 villages are neighbouring to the lake from the Srinagar side and requested that ETS may kindly be provided him for the demarcation purpose. The chair directed that demarcation of Anchar Lake from Srinagar side shall be completed by or before 30.04.2021.
