
At the outset, the Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir while welcoming all the participants informed that from last some months directions have been passed to all the Deputy Commissioners and HODs for description / display/hoisting of National Flag strictly as per the Flag code of India 2002 and to ensure that there is no violation in this regard. Thereafter, the chair was apprised that Flag Foundation of India have proposed to Hoist a biz size flag at Hariparbat Fort at a height of 100 feet having the description of 24 feet X 36 Feet and sought all the necessary logistic support from the Divisional Administration as well as from the stake holders viz. Archaeological Survey of India, UT of J&K, Forest Department, Airport Authority of India, Tourism Department.

3.	Construction of Foundation / Digging.	<p>The chair directed that either Archaeological Survey of India shall carryout the excavation/digging process by themselves or by Flag Foundation of India under the overall supervision of ASI but it shall be strictly ensure that if anything having archaeological scope is found at the site shall be cared properly and handover immediately to ASI. Moreover, it shall be ensured that there is no damage to the monument.</p> <p>The chair further, directed that the foundation for the flag shall be completed within 15 days positively, enable the authorities to hoist the flag well before the August 05, 2021.</p> <p><i>Ch</i></p>	Dir. 4.	Plantation of Conifer	Urban Forestry Deptt. shall explore possibility of planting of conifer plants at the site in large numbers.	DFO Urban Forest Srinagar
5.	Mock Drill	As the participants apprised the chair that as per the description of the proposed flag it is very difficult to man the daily state of affairs in this regard, the chair directed that a mock drill/trial shall be conducted in this regard viz, same size of cloth be hoisted/furled in advance.	Dir. ASI/Flag Foundation of India./ CE ,Mech
6.	Logistic support by mechanical Engineering Deptt.	Chief Engineer, Mechanical, Kashmir shall provide logical/mechanical support to the Flag foundation of India/HQ 31-Sub Area in installation of the large flag at the site.	CE, Mechanical Kmr.
