Subject:- District level Meeting on various issues.

A meeting under the chairmanship of Mr. Baseer Ahmad Khan, IAS, Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir was held on 24.09.2019 at 11.00 AM at Deputy Commissioner Office Bandipora regarding the review on developmental issues /schemes of all sectors.

Deputy Commissioner Bandipora alongwith all the District Level officers participated in the meeting.

The meeting focused on the following points.

- i. Status of Rs.5.00 crores sanctioned to each district.
- ii. Status of opening /Operation of accounts of Panches/Sarpanches.
- iii. Holding of Gram Sabhas.
- iv. Status of issuance of weaker section certificates.
- v. Monitoring of various programmes under languishing projects.
- vi. Finalization of PDD Towers.
- vii. Position of essential supplies.
- viii. Functioning of Schools/hospitals/offices.
 - ix. Model village in tribal areas.
 - x. Status of land to be identified for Anti corruption Bureau (ACB).
 - xi. Mapping out of details of Land Bank State/Kacharai to be utilized for various projects especially for Industrial ventures and Industrial estates.
- xii. Status of PMGSY cases.

At the outset, the chair sought feedback on above points and accordingly discussed with the officers of Departments/agencies viz, Education, Health, PHE/Electricity/R&B ,CA&PD, IOC, HPCL, SICOP, Social Welfare, Horticulture, Agriculture etc and issued necessary directions to the concerned officers for smooth functioning and early completion of the works in a time bound manner. The works on the languishing projects shall be completed/resumed immediately after exploring the possibilities of engaging the local labour. Besides, the officers should reach out to the

public/villages, listen their grievances and utilize resources to mitigate their problems. It was assured in the meeting that full support shall be provided by the Divisional Administration.

After brief interaction with the Deputy Commissioner and his team of officers on the point wise agenda, following decisions/instructions were passed:-

Status of Rs. 5.00 crore sanctioned to district:- It was apprised that the action plan in this regard has been framed and approved by DDC for Rs. 14.73 crores, besides the estimation and accord of AAs are under progress. 70 estimates have been framed and at least 05 works are under execution.	'The chair directed that the remaining work of estimation and administrative approval shall be completed ten in days
Status of opening/operation of joint accounts of Sarpanches: It was apprised that out of total 151 Panchayats joint accounts in 107 have been opened.	"'The chair directed that remaining work in this regard shall be completed within a week. A joint inspection by the teams of police, revenue and allied departments in respect of basic amenities available in the building identified for the election of Block Dev. Council shall be carried within a week. The voters(Panches/Sarpanchs) shall be given to-and-fro escort and transport facility"
Holding of Plastic Free campaign:- The calendar in this regard has been issued and sanitation drive in Municipal council Bandipora and Hajin is going on with full pace. Besides such drives in some panchayats of Bankote block stands conducted.	It was directed that officers should reach out to the public/ villages, listen their grievances and utlize resoures to mitigate their problems. The community participation viz, traders, employees, volunteers etc shall be involved in such activities to sensitize the general public and explore possibilities of providing jute/paper bags to the traders as an alternative to reduce the incidence of plastic use.
Status of issuance of weaker section certificates:- It was apprised that the 1000 certificates have been issued by concerned Tehsildars as procedure	The circular/order issued be implemented in letter and sprit. Besides, special camps

'The chair stressed that a time line with regard to completion of these projects shall be drawn and shall be intensively monitored by the Deputy Commissioner and in this regard inter departmental teams shall be constituted. The works carried out by the R&B Departments shall be verified by the DC and report in this regard shall be submitted to Divisional Commissioner Office. The works PHE/R&B/PDD/SICOP etc in the district , especially in Gurez sub division shall be resumed immediately after exploring the possibilities of engaging the local labourers.

Finalization of PDD Towers. It was apprised that out of 111 towers the foundation of 110 towers have been completed. Besides, erection of 107 towers have been completed and 04 towers viz, Tower No, 47(Ajas), Tower No. Tower 56(SK Payeen) No.93 (Nusoo), Tower No. 15 (Manasbal) is incomplete. Out of total stringing of line of 31 Kms, 24 kms have been completed. However, a compensation amount of Rs,4.00 crores is urgently required.

It was further apprised that the Workshops at Ganderbal and Bandipora are fully functional and presently there is no issue of electricity in the District. Besides, bills to the subscribers of the disitrict have been issued and the people are ready to pay the dues.

"The chair directed the DC to extend the commitment on his behalf that they shall get the compensation within a week, otherwise, impose the directions of "compulsory acqusition of land". The chair announced that the completion of the PDD works/towers shall mitigate the power crises of district Bandipora."

The chair further directed that the PDD officials officers shall reach out to the public and detailed report shall be submitted to me with regard to deficiency/need of transformers or any other issue to meet out the crises.

Position of essential supplies:- It was apprised that for the month of September, 22667.00 Qtls of rice has been lifted against monthly allocation of 22667 Otls

"The chair directed to the DC to meet/complete the remaining target dumping of essential commodities /remaining LPG stocks for the whole

and the saving/availability for the month of August are 1770 Qtls. It was intimated that the stocking of rice is completed. The LPG has been lifted/ distributed and sufficient stocks of petrol/diesel are available in the district.

district especially in the Gurez and other snow bound areas in 06 days and report to the office of Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir accordingly.

Functioning of Schools/ hospitals/ offices:-The chair was apprised that on an average 90% of the staff in the offices remain present in the schools and 8% of students remain present. The schools in Koil Mugam and Gurez are Besides. all the Health functional. Institutions in the district are functioning and 98% staff remain present in the other offices. There is no shortage of medicines in all the health institutions of the district. Besides, the 100% dumping of essential medicines have been done in Gurez.

"The chair directed that 100% attendance of employees be ensured in the offices/schools/hospitals and the action against the absentees without bonafide reasons shall be initiated immediately. The report in this regard shall be submitted to DC for onward transmission to Divisional Commissioner."

Model village in tribal areas:- It was apprised that Rs.10.00 crores has been earmarked for the Model Villages in Tribal areas under TSP.In this regard 6 villages have been identified. "

"'The DPR of all the six villages viz, Arin, Dardpora, Sumlar, Chuntimullah, Kudara and Srindar shall be submitted within one week.

Mapping out of details of Land Bank State/Kacharai to be utilized for various projects especially for Industrial ventures and Industrial estates:- It was apprised the mapping process except three Tehsils have been completed and the remaining work will be completed in next 4 days.

"The remaining work shall be completed in 2-3 days and a report in this regard shall be submitted to Divisional Commissioner, Office.

Status of PMGSY cases. It was apprised that the total amount assessed for PMGSY cases before 10th phase is Rs.24.10 crores and Rs. 19.86 crores have been received, out of which Rs.18.08 crores have been disbursed.

The remaining work shall be completed within a week.

Status of Social Welfare Schemes. It was appriased that old age pension is directly being credited to the beneficiaries in their
