Subject:- Allowing sick, pregnant ladies, old & feeble persons, persons appearing for examinations/interviews and staff of essential services to move during Cordon and Search Operations (CASO).

Few days back, it was brought to the notice that a pregnant lady was not allowed to proceed to hospital during Cordon and Search Operations (CASO) at Kakroosa, Kupwara, resultantly the lady delivered the baby in the premises of the Primary Health Centre without the assistance of Medical Staff deployed at NTPHC, Kakroosa as none of the Medical Staff also allowed to proceed to the Health Centre to attend to their duties. This has created an embarrassing situation for the Administration. However, this type of situation needs to be dealt seriously in future to avoid any awkward position. During CASO or otherwise, we all are required to be sensitized enough to show sympathy and concern to the common people and their need, especially in the hour of medical and other emergency.

Therefore, to avoid such a situation in future, it is enjoined upon all the security agencies engaged in such operation and field duties to issue necessary instructions to the field formation/search parties to ensure that sick, pregnant ladies, old & feeble persons, persons appearing for examinations/interviews and staff of essential services like Medical, Fire Services, PHE, PDD are allowed to move during CASO. The identity cards of the govt. officials and admit cards of examinees and interviewees shall be treated as Movement Passes. In case of patients, visual observation of the officer/jawans should be adequate about making suitable judgement about the genuineness of his/her claim on spot.
